

Housing is top on BN list

Housing will be the top of the list to be tackled by the Barisan Nasional (BN) agenda if it recapture Penang in the coming general election.

State MCA chief Datuk Seri Dr Ng Yen Yen said many residents were disappointed with the opposition's failure to provide them with affordable homes.

"Properties in Penang have gone more expensive, beyond the means of the average citizen and it took the state government to build affordable housing units," she said at a press conference at the Bukit Gelugor MCA division office here yesterday.

Dr Ng said the DAP-led state government had not given Penangites a clear idea of its vision for Penang.

Meanwhile, she also said that Penang MCA was prepared to fight hard to win back the people's support in the coming general elections and that some Chinese voters were returning to BN.

"We must have hopes that BN can win back Penang. Otherwise, there is no point fighting at all." she said, adding that the party would do more house-to-house visits to meet with the electorates.
