UNFULFILLED PROMISES: Selangor govt has failed to address problems faced by the people, says BN

KUALA LUMPUR: THE people of Selangor should reject the Parti Keadilan Rakyat-led state government for their failure to address the people's problems and their various antics since taking office 1,400 days ago.

Barisan Nasional Selangor coordinator Datuk Seri Mohd Zin Mohamed said Pakatan Rakyat loved to make promises but was weak in fighting for the rights of the people.

He said Pakatan's test to govern Selangor was over as they had four years to do so.

"If road maintenance works in the state failed to be done, what more can be said?"

"Also, basic issues for the people's convenience were not settled," he said.

"Maybe the allocation for road maintenance was not fully utilised but was used for something else," he alleged.

"So, to the voters of Selangor, what are you waiting for?"

"It is even sad that many of the Federal government's transformational programme for the people's welfare were rejected by Pakatan just because of political differences.

"So, the time has come for the people to reject them," he said.

On Sunday, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak told the people of Selangor to reject the state government for its failure to keep its election promises.

Among the unfulfilled promises include reduction of assessment rates and business premises tax by 20 per cent, free medical services to the elderly, RM600 a month for each single mother, RM1,000 for students pursuing higher education and RM50 to be paid to each preschooler.

Non-governmental organisation Gagasan Anti-Penyelewengan Selangor chairman Hamidzun Khairuddin said the test period for the opposition-led government in Selangor was over because they had failed to run the state as its leaders were involved in various scandals and immoral activities.
