

Felda youths to get RM7.535mil

KUALA LUMPUR: Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said Sunday that an allocation of RM7.535 mil will be made for Felda youth empowerment programmes.

In a Karnival Iktiraf for Felda settlers in Dataran Merdeka on Sunday noon, representing Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, he said, that the allocation included RM4 mil to the Felda Malaysia Youth Council (MBFM) and RM5,000 for the administration of 317 Felda youth groups.

RM1 mil would go for the welfare of Felda students in local and foreign universities.

"We have to continue in our mission as the youth defenders of race. We have to strengthen the three social missions of the Felda youths.

"Felda youths must be free from drugs, crime and vice; be perfectly educated and work with high skills; and fight for the religion, race and country."

Muhyiddin reaffirmed the government's promise of a windfall for Felda settlers.
