

**Ministers laud positive report card**

KUALA LUMPUR: The Government has proven that it can deliver on its promises.

Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said the "report card" unveiled to the *rakyat* showed the Government's commitment to putting "people first".

"I don't believe any other Government in the world is this transparent," he said after the announcement of the second set of results for the GTP initiatives yesterday.

He said the Barisan Nasional government was "the driver" that was taking the country towards achieving Vision 2020.

He noted that economic analysts from several other countries were impressed after speaking to Performance Management and Delivery Unit (Pemandu) CEO Datuk Seri Idris Jala about the initiatives.

Home Minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein said the Government's transparency showed confidence and courage.

"The most important thing is for the people to know that we are transparent and that we are able to deliver on our promises," he said.

Information, Communication and Culture Minister Datuk Seri Dr Rais Yatim urged Malaysia to continue giving Barisan Nasional the mandate to govern the country.

"We are already halfway towards becoming a developed and high-income nation."

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Idris Jala said: "The confidence created by the ETP also resulted in Malaysia's 2011 foreign direct investment to increase by 12.3% to RM32.9bil as compared to 2010, the highest in 10 years. Trade grew 8.7% to RM1.27tril last year alone."
