

## Assess Govt based on performance, says MCA president

KUALA LUMPUR: The *rakyat* should evaluate the Government based on its performance and not on promises made by Pakatan Rakyat, said MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Chua Soi Lek.

He added that the Government Transformation Programme had delivered results.

"We have always supported the GTP. It is important to ensure that we achieve a high-income nation status by 2020.

"This new economic model and the GTP are important because if we do not succeed and deliver, we will be left behind, lagging behind even Vietnam or Indonesia," Dr Chua said.

He added that the *rakyat* should measure and value the Government based on its performance and not on promises.

"If you look at Pakatan's election manifesto, there is very little on economic or Governmental transformation," he said yesterday when asked about last year's GTP results.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said that the GTP targets and milestones last year were not only achieved, but were exceeded in some cases.

Pakatan, Dr Chua added, merely talked about what the *rakyat* liked to hear, such as reducing corruption or abuse of power, instead of addressing and dealing with all issues.

"I am not saying that there is no corruption or abuse of power. These are important (to address) but you also need other initiatives to achieve a high-income nation status," Dr Chua said.
