

Bersih to hold rally on April 28

PETALING JAYA: Election watchdog Bersih 2.0 announced on Wednesday it will hold a rally on April 28 to push for electoral reforms.

It said in a statement that the rally, themed "Duduk Bantah," would be held at Dataran Merdeka in Kuala Lumpur from 2pm and other places nationwide.

On Tuesday, the Parliamentary Select Committee on Electoral Reforms tabled its final report in Parliament with 22 recommendations covering voter registration, maintaining a clean electoral roll, dissolution of Parliament, campaigning and polling.

The nine-member committee is headed by Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Datuk Seri Dr Maximus Ongkili with MPs from both sides of the political divide and an Independent.
