

**Govt has kept promises, says DPM**

KUALA LUMPUR: The results of the Government Transformation Programme (GTP) initiative prove that the Government can deliver on its promises, said Barisan Nasional leaders.

Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said the “report card” unveiled to the *rakyat* displayed their commitment to putting “people first”.

“I don't believe that any other Government is this transparent with its people,” he said after the announcement of the second set of results for the GTP initiatives at Angkasapuri on Monday night.

He said that the Barisan government was “the driver” that's bringing the country forward towards achieving Vision 2020 and called on Malaysians to work together with them.

“Don't choose the wrong driver' for the journey as the country may not reach its destination then,” he said.

Muhyiddin added that economic analysts from several other countries were impressed after speaking to Performance Management and Delivery Unit (Pemandu) CEO Datuk Seri Idris Jala about the initiatives.

Home Minister Datuk Seri Hishammuddin Hussein said the Government's transparency to the people through the GTP results showed confidence and courage.

“The most important thing is for the people to know that we are transparent and able to deliver on our promises,” he said.

Information, Communication and Culture Minister Datuk Seri Rais Yatim urged Malaysia to continue giving Barisan the mandate to govern the country.

“We are already halfway towards realising Vision 2020 of becoming a developed and high-income nation.

“Only if we are given the mandate again, can we accomplish what we started,” he said.
