

PKR welcomes Shahrizat's decision to step down

PETALING JAYA: PKR has welcomed Datuk Seri Shahrizat Abdul Jalil's intention to step down.

However, the party believes that the public want the Government to ensure that the RM250mil loan meant for the National Feedlot Corporation (NFCorp) is fully recovered.

PKR director of strategies Rafizi Ramli said: "We still have to give credit to her for realising that it is the right thing to do. It is better late than never.

"She realised that society has changed," he said.

The resignation, according to PKR vice-president Nurul Izzah Anwar and Lembah Pantai MP, had not changed the Opposition's stand in calling for a Royal Committee of Inquiry into the matter.

DAP publicity secretary Tony Pua said Shahrizat's announcement would not take the heat off the Government over the alleged irregularities in NFCorp.

Pua and Rafizi also insisted that those found guilty should be brought to book and that they would not let up until that happens.
