

**Najib: Stay united to win back Selangor**

SUBANG JAYA: Barisan Nasional leaders have been urged to close ranks and ensure the coalition is united and strong.

Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said this was necessary if Barisan was to regain Selangor in the next general election.

"Let us be united, loyal to the president and the party. If we are united and pick the right candidate that we all support, Barisan can win," he said during a meet-the-people session for the five parliamentary constituencies of Sepang, Hulu Langat, Puchong, Serdang and Kuala Langat held at SMK Putra Perdana yesterday.

The Prime Minister said the enthusiastic crowd that attended the event had made him more confident that Selangor would return to Barisan.

Najib then asked the crowd when they wanted an election and to his question, "Anytime?" they answered "*Boleh!* (Can)".

He admitted that although Barisan had made mistakes in the past, the coalition would learn from them.

"We will rise again to govern our country better," he added.

Najib, who is also Selangor Barisan chairman, said he wanted to give up his position to someone from the state but did not disclose any names.

"Let Selangor be governed by fellow Selangor citizens," he said.

He added that Barisan had shown that it did not make empty promises.

"We have proven that we are capable of taking action and implementing (initiatives) for the past three years," he said.

He also announced that the Barisan Government had given an allocation of RM100,000 to Surau Sakinah and RM200,000 to the school.

During the event, Najib also presented contributions to parent-teacher associations from schools in each of the five constituencies as well as incentives to 250 students who achieved excellent examination results.

Also present were his wife Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor and Selangor MCA chairman Datuk Donald Lim.
