**Committee won't touch on matters involving court case, says chairman**

KUALA LUMPUR: The Public Accounts Committee (PAC) will continue probing the National Feedlot Corporation (NFCorp) scandal but will not touch on matters involving the case in court.

PAC chairman Datuk Seri Azmi Khalid said this following Dewan Rakyat Speaker Tan Sri Pandikar Amin Mulia's ruling Wednesday that the committee could not touch on issues concerning the court case.

"We will probe on how Government funds are used, how they were approved and problems that arose from the scandal," he told reporters after chairing the PAC meeting at the Parliament building here.

Azmi said the PAC had also requested for documents, including loan agreements, from the Finance Ministry, and Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Ministry to be submitted by this week.
