

**Report lodged against PKR for pro-Jewish leanings**

KUALA LUMPUR: Umno Youth has accused the PKR of aligning with pro-Jewish groups to win the general election.

"These groups may use tactics that can cause unrest in the country, like launching a hatred campaign against certain sections of the community," said Selangor Umno Youth information chief Safarizul Mustafa.

"We are against the involvement of foreign groups in national matters, especially those connected with pro-Jewish sentiments," he said after leading a group from the movement to lodge a police report against PKR at the Ampang Jaya police station here yesterday.

The report was made following an article in a Malay daily on March 14 that quoted Selangor Umno secretary Datuk Seri Mohd Zin Mohamed as claiming the opposition party was forming alliances with foreign organisations like the Konrad Adenauer Foundation and the National Democracy Institute.

Safarizul urged the police to investigate the claim and work to preserve the peace and security in the country.

Ampang Jaya OCPD Asst Comm Amiruddin Jamaluddin confirmed a police report had been lodged.
