

PM: Govt's response to people's wishes has seen growing support for BN

PORT DICKSON: Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said the government's response to the people's wishes has seen a growing support for the ruling coalition as it gained more of the people's trust.

The Prime Minister and Barisan Nasional chairman said the Barisan's approach to gaining the people's trust and confidence was by presenting them with facts and undertaking the changes they wanted.

This was contrary to the Opposition's lies and “fiction”.

“The Barisan is not out to just gain popularity. We want to do good for the people and country,” he said at a luncheon hosted for the local community at the Dataran Kompleks Daerah and Tanah Port Dickson by the beachfront in Teluk Kemang.

Najib said the facts proved the country's revenue had increased significantly and because of this, the Government could distribute RM500 aid to families earning below RM3,000, saying the Opposition created “fiction” by claiming otherwise.

Earlier, the PM witnessed the handing over of 70 units of affordable homes to the state government.

Najib said the by-election for Bagan Pinang state seat in Negri Sembilan was a turning point for the Barisan after the 2008 political tsunami.

“I hope to see even greater victories. We have done a lot of changes for the people in the past three years and there will be more to come if we are given the mandate again,” he said.
