

MIC wooing voters in key states

KUALA LUMPUR: The MIC will embark on a campaign to woo Indian voters in Selangor, Perak and Kedah from next month, says party president Datuk Seri G. Palanivel.

"These three states are important battlegrounds to us.

"We want Indian votes to come back (in support of MIC).

"It is a question of winning the hearts and minds of the voters," he said in a statement yesterday.

Palanivel said the three state MIC liaison committees would engage the voters.

"The exercise will enable us to touch base with voters and get feedback on important issues," he said, adding that the party must go into full gear in preparing for the general election.
