

Najib: Support for BN peaking

HULU LANGAT: Support is peaking for Barisan Nasional, Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak told residents here in another clear sign of a looming general election.

"The winds are now blowing strongly towards Barisan," he said before handing out aid to flood victims at the Nurani Rakyat programme here Sunday.

He said the people were more inclined towards supporting Barisan as they were aware of Pakatan Rakyat's unfulfilled promises.

"Confidence in Barisan has increased and is peaking," he said, adding that he noted the positive mood while visiting Telok Kemang, Negri Sembilan, on Saturday night.

Najib presented cash aid and assistance amounting to RM7mil to 3,528 victims and announced a RM7.5mil allocation for temporary flood mitigation works.

He noted that long-term flood mitigation for Hulu Langat required the acquisition of land for the construction of water retention ponds.

The long-term measures, he added, would be better carried out when Barisan recaptures Selangor from Pakatan.
