

**MCA Youth hold peaceful demo to protest violence against Wee**

IPOH: About 30 MCA Youth members held a peaceful demonstration here to condemn the violence against Deputy Education Minister Datuk Dr Wee Ka Siong.

Holding banners in front of the Perak MCA headquarters here on Wednesday, they denounced the attempts by participants of last Sunday's United Chinese School Committees Association (Dong Zong) rally in Selangor to assault and intimidate Dr Wee.

Ipoh Timur MCA Youth chief Tony Khoo, who led the protest attended by Youth members from the Ipoh Timur, Ipoh Barat, Gopeng and Batu Gajah divisions, said they wanted to show their support for the MCA Youth chief.

Condemning the attack against Dr Wee, Khoo said any demonstration must be held peacefully.

"We must resist the culture of violence, otherwise the country will end up having Middle East-type demonstrations.

"Please give some time for Dr Wee to try to solve the shortage of Chinese school teachers. He has been doing his best," he said.
