

**Najib: M'sia confident of reforms now taking place in Myanmar**

NAYPYITAW: Myanmar has given the assurance that reforms now being implemented are irreversible and the civilian government is committed towards turning the country into a democratic and inclusive one.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, who is encouraged by the assurance given personally by President Thein Sein, said Malaysian companies should not delay their participation in Myanmar's booming economy.

"This visit has been very encouraging and Malaysia is even more confident with the reforms taking place as it shows the country is in transition to a more open, democratic and progressive country.

"This is a process that needs our support . I have told the President that Malaysia will try to convince developed countries to review the sanctions imposed against Myanmar and if they cannot do it immediately, it should be done in stages," Najib told Malaysian media at the end of two-day official visit to Myanmar.
