

Chua: PAS 'shortchanging' DAP, PKR in Kedah

KULIM: MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Chua Soi Lek has hit out at PAS for "shortchanging" DAP and PKR in Kedah.

He said PAS' recent arrangement for Kedah to be administered by the party's Central Committee left DAP and PKR elected representatives in a quandry.

"By allowing PAS' Central Committee to administer the Kedah state government, the party has denied Kedahans their rights and aspirations.

"The people chose Mentri Besar Datuk Seri Azizan Abdul Razak and his state excos to administer the state, not the PAS central committee," he said after meeting non-governmental organisation heads from South Kedah at the Chinese Recreation Club here Thursday.

Chua stressed that the Kedah administration was under Pakatan Rakyat, which made up of PAS, DAP and PKR.

He said he was puzzled as to why PKR and DAP had chosen to keep silent on the matter.

He said the situation in Kedah was akin to a Chinese proverb, 'Dang Jia Bu Dang Quan' (A host with no power).

"I believe the DAP in Kedah is not bold enough to stand up to PAS.

"It does not have the ability to control the actions taken by PAS," he said.
