

**DPM Chairs Meeting Of Cabinet Committee On Human Capital Development

PUTRAJAYA, Feb 10 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today chaired a meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Human Capital Development, here.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Tan Sri Nor Mohamed Yakcop, Higher Education Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Khaled Nordin, Human Resource Minister Datuk Dr S. Subramaniam, Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Minister Datuk Seri Noh Omar and several deputy ministers also attended the meeting.

Several working papers were tabled at the meeting, including on the status of job creation according to the National Key Economic Areas (NKEA)/Entry Point Projects (EPP), the implementation status of the strategic reform initiatives for human capital development by the Performance Management and Delivery Unit (Pemandu).

The meeting also discussed an analysis of the implementation of the upskilling programme and a review of the proposal for the setting up of an oversight body and a merger of the skills, technical and vocational sectors by the Economic Planning Unit under the Prime Minister's Department.

Also tabled were working papers prepared by the Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Ministry on the direction of the national agricultural training programmes, and by the Higher Education Ministry on sustainable development of Information Communication Technology (ICT) human capital.

Throughout last year, the cabinet committee had discussed in detail 14 working papers to find solutions to various issues in a bid to create highly skilled human capital with strong values to take the country's development to greater heights.
