

Muhyiddin Hopes Pay Revision For Teachers To Be Expedited

KULAIJAYA, March 10 (Bernama) -- The deputy prime minister has expressed his hope that the Public Service Department would expedite the salary adjustments for the teachers' scheme of service.

Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, who is also education minister, said the National Union of the Teaching Profession has welcomed the abolition of the Public Service New Remuneration Scheme (SBPA) announced by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

"We hope that the salary adjustments based on the improved version of the Malaysian Remuneration System following the abolition of the SBPA will be implemented soon.

"The teachers are hoping that the much awaited salary increase will be implemented as soon as possible," he told reporters after attending the 1Malaysia Caring Expedition at the Kem Bina Negara, Gunung Pulai here, today.

Muhyiddin said the government would fulfil promises made to teachers.
