

**Muhyiddin Begins Day-Long Visit To Perak

IPOH, Feb 11 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin began his one-day visit to Perak today with a meeting with Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abdul Kadir at the menteri besar's official residence here.

Muhyiddin and his wife, Puan Sri Noorainee Abdul Rahman, were greeted upon arrival at about 8.30 am by Dr Zambry and his wife, Datin Seri Saripah Zulkifli, and they had breakfast there.

Also present were Defence Minister and Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi and several leaders of Barisan Nasional (BN) component parties.

Muhyiddin, who is BN deputy chairman and Umno deputy president, is scheduled to hold closed-door meetings with the Perak Umno Liaison Committee and the Perak BN Liaison Committee at the Umno building, here.

Muhyiddin, who is also education minister, is also scheduled to attend a meeting here with educators in Perak.

The deputy prime minister will also meet the people at the field of Sekolah Kebangsaan Kampung Bahagia in Teluk Intan.

Meanwhile, Noorainee is scheduled to have a breakfast meeting with the Charity Organisation of Wives of Perak Elected Representatives (Baiduri) and attend a Chinese New Year celebration with the Perak Chinese Single Mothers Association at the menteri besar's official residence.

She is also scheduled to visit the women's and children's wards at the Raja Permaisuri Bainun Hospital here.
