

**Transformation Programmes Endearing People To BN In Perak - Muhyiddin

IPOH, Feb 11 (Bernama) -- The various transformation programmes of the Barisan Nasional (BN) in Perak have made the people in the state see the state government in a positive light, Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said.

However, the BN leaders should not be driven to complacency by this change in the people but must work harder to retain the state government in the next general election, he added.

"Over the last three years, there has been much progress. The BN's programmes have endeared the people towards the coalition," he told reporters after a dialogue with educators in Perak here as part of his one-day visit to the state.

Muhyiddin said there are positive signs of the BN retaining Perak in the next general election because the people see the sincerity of the BN and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak in championing their cause.

"Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abd Kadir is going down to the ground to meet the people. All these give us hope of retaining our position," he said.

"We have to explain these issues to the people or they will be confused," he said.
