

**Government Ensures People Remain Healthy To Serve Nation - Muhyiddin

PAGOH, Oct 13 (Bernama) -- The government continues to upgrade health services despite having globally recognised infrastructure and standards because it wants to ensure everyone is healthy to contribute to the country's development, Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said.

He said the health services are enjoyed not only by people in the urban areas but also in the rural villages by way of programmes such as the "Doktor Turun Kampung" (Doctor in the Field) in the Pagoh parliamentary constituency.

"This programme is above and beyond the normal services provided by the government whereby the doctor examines the villagers and understands their health needs," said Muhyiddin, who is the MP for Pagoh.

Muhyiddin spoke at the "Doktor Turun Kampung" programme in Kampung Sentosa, Lenga, here. The programme is Muhyiddin's brainchild.

After its launch, the programme detected 500 school children in the constituency who did not have perfect vision and had to wear glasses.

Muhyiddin also handed over RM128,650 to 221 needy people and three non-governmental organisations in the Lenga/Bukit Kepong zone under a special programme.
