JITRA, 14 Feb (Bernama) -- Puan Sri Noorainee Abdul Rahman, the wife of the Deputy Prime Minister, today visited the Kubang Pasu community based centre (PDK), near here, for a friendly meeting with the trainees.

She also took part in the birthday celebration of one of the trainees there, Fatin Nursyura Mahzan, 20, and gave away souvenirs.

She also launched a Jitra PDK Products Workshop which was opened in February last year.
