

**Announcement On NFC Action Soon, Says DPM

KANGAR, Jan 14 (Bernama) -- The government will announce, in the near future, the steps it will take to handle the issues being faced by the National Feedlot Corporation, said Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today.

He said the government was planning the solution and he would be discussing the outcome with Agriculture Minister Datuk Seri Noh Omar before meeting up with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

He said NFC's assets have been temporarily frozen and the Prime Minister has appointed him and Noh to monitor the corporation.

"I have discussed it with the PM that the issue has been manipulated by the opposition and it has reached a stage where the government will take action and announce the same in the near future," he said after distributing 1Malaysia People's Aid at the Dewan 2020 here.

The government will review all aspects in relation to NFC including its contract with the company, he added.

Once the matter has been presented to the PM, it will be announced to the public, said Muhyiddin.

He also remarked that the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) and police investigations may be used as guidelines.

MACC recently announced that the case of a condominium purchase with NFC funds has been handed over to the Commercial Crimes Department director.

The NFC issue surfaced after the 2010 Auditor-General report in October stated that the corporation had failed to comply with the objectives of its formation.
