

**Have Wisdom In Determining Future: Muhyiddin  
Bernama

PADANG BESAR, Jan 14 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Mohd Yassin wants the people to exercise wisdom in determining their future despite being continuously bombarded by lies being spread by the opposition about the government's initiatives.

He said the country's future depends on the Barisan Nasional (BN) which he said had proven its effectiveness in administering the country.

"People should support the government and its policies so that what has been achieved thus far is being not tinkered with and there will be a clearer future for the country," he said at the opening of the Seri Melati Hall, held at a get-together event with Padang Besar constituents in Beseri, near here.

The RM3.2 million hall can accommodate over 600 people and is the main multipurpose hall for the constituency.

Muhyiddin, who is Umno deputy president, also hoped that the people would not be easily sway by the lies being spread by the opposition, describing the pact as being mired in internal problems due to policy differences.

For instance, he said PAS had abandoned its policy to form an Islamic state if it ruled the country after its partners shown preference for a welfare state.

"They have no consensus, no vision or common approach," he said.

He added that the opposition, through various means including using the social media, would tell more lies ahead of the coming election in their effort to gain sympathy, by accusing the government of being cruel, irresponsible, corrupt and not helpful to the people.

Muhyiddin expressed concerns about the lies being accepted as the truth when told repeatedly.

He told the gathering that the country's leadership had exercised wisdom in tackling numerous issues, resulting in continuous growth in the country's economy even as other countries were grappling with economic crises.

Muhyiddin then performed a symbolic launched of the 1Malaysia People's Assistance (BR1M) in the state.
