

Muhyiddin Begins Day-Long Visit To Pahang

KUANTAN, Feb 16 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin arrived here today on a one-day visit to Pahang.

Muhyiddin and his wife, Puan Seri Noorainee Abdul Rahman, flew in to the Sultan Ahmad Shah airport at 8.20 am and were greeted by Pahang Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob and other state government leaders.

Muhyiddin then held a closed-door meeting with Adnan, who is also chairman of the Pahang Umno Liaison Committee.

The deputy prime minister is also scheduled to officiate at a parade to mark the 7th anniversary of Maritime Day at the Malaysian Maritime Enforcement Agency (MMEA) training centre in Gebeng and attend a 1Malaysia People's Reception at the Air Balok recreation centre.

He is also scheduled to attend a meeting with state Barisan Nasional leaders at the Pahang Foundation complex in the afternoon before returning to Kuala Lumpur.
