

Muhyiddin Arrives In Sabah For Official Visit

KOTA KINABALU, Jan 16 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin arrived here Monday for a two-day official visit to Sabah.

Muhyiddin arrived on a special aircraft at Terminal 2, Kota Kinabalu International Airport at about 4.40pm.

He was accompanied by Sabah Chief Minister Datuk Seri Musa Aman, Home Minister Datuk Hishammuddin Tun Hussein and Umno secretary-general Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Mansur and they were greeted by the Deputy Chief Ministers, cabinet members and heads of the federal and state departments as well as community leaders.

Muhyiddin will attend a closed-door dinner with the State Umno Liaison Body and Barisan Nasional Committee at 7pm.

Tuesday, he is scheduled to depart for Semporna and expected to arrive in the district at about 9.20am to attend a gathering with the people as well as the presentation of the 1Malaysia Public Aid (BR1M) at Semporna Town Field at 10am.

He will also have a special meeting with teachers, Parent-Teacher Associations (PTAs), civil servants and community leaders at the Semporna Community Hall before departing for the federal capital at 5pm.
