

Muhyiddin Arrives In Penang For Day-Long Working Visit

BUTTERWORTH, Sept 17 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin arrived here today to begin a day-long working visit to Penang.

The Barisan Nasional (BN) deputy chairman flew in to the Royal Malaysian Air Force (RMAF) base at about 8 am and was welcomed by Penang Umno Liaison Committee chairman Datuk Zainal Abidin Osman and other state BN leaders.

He is scheduled to meet the people in five parliamentary constituencies, namely Tasek Gelugor, Permatang Pauh, Bukit Mertajam, Nibong Tebal and Batu Kawan.

In the Tasek Gelugor constituency, which is the only one of the five held by the BN, he is scheduled to hold a dialogue with traders before looking at the progress of the double-track railway project.

In Permatang Pauh, he will meet religious school teachers from the state at Universiti Teknologi Mara while in Bukit Mertajam he is scheduled to visit the site for relocation of flood victims in Kampung Manggis.

In Nibong Tebal, he will attend a 1Malaysia Aidilfitri reception in Sungai Aceh and meet the constituents while in Batu Kawan, he will perform the ground-breaking for a Tamil school in Bukit Tambun and address the constituents.

Muhyiddin is scheduled to return to Kuala Lumpur in the evening.
