

Muhyiddin To Visit Singapore Monday

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 21 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin will make a two-day official visit to Singapore beginning Monday.

He is scheduled to call on Singapore Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong and Deputy Prime Minister Teo Chee Hean, and have a meeting with Education Minister Heng Swee Keat, the Foreign Ministry said in a statement today. Muhyiddin is also Education Minister.

Muhyiddin's itinerary includes visits to the Institute of Technical Education, the Singapore Tourism Board and the Tuas incineration plant.

"The official visit will reinforce the long-standing ties and collaboration between the two close neighbours," the statement said.

Muhyiddin will be accompanied by his wife Puan Sri Noorainee Abdul Rahman.

His delegation will include Deputy Housing and Local Government Minister Datuk Seri Lajim Ukin, Deputy Tourism Minister Datuk Dr James Dawos Mamit as well as senior Foreign Ministry officials.
