

**Muhyiddin Flies Into Kelantan For Day-Long Visit**

KOTA BAHARU, Nov 23 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin flew into Kelantan today for a day-long visit, and was welcomed by 200 Barisan Nasional leaders attired in red and federal government officers.

International Trade and Industry Minister and Kelantan BN and Umno chairman Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed and Deputy Finance Minister and Kelantan Umno deputy chairman Datuk Dr Awang Adek Hussin were among those who greeted Muhyiddin at the Sultan Ismail Petra Airport in Pengkalan Chepa at 8.30 am.

Soon after arrival, Muhyiddin chaired a meeting of the Kelantan BN Liaison Committee at the meeting room of the airport.

Muhyiddin, who is also education minister, is scheduled to attend a town hall meeting with representatives of religious schools and present federal government aid.

He is also scheduled to present a cheque to Madrasah Tahfiz Al-Quran Al-Ismallah in Pasir Mas for the construction of a new building.

The deputy prime minister's itinerary will also take him to Tanah Merah and Machang before he flies back to Kuala Lumpur at about 5 pm.
