

**Muhyiddin: Remark On Lim's Son Twisted By Alternative Media**

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 24 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin told the Dewan Rakyat today that the statement he made on Saturday on the issue concerning the son of Penang Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng, has been twisted by the alternative media.

He said he had no intention to drag Lim's family matters into politics and that he only made a suggestion that a police report be made to clear the air over the matter.

"I don't want to interfere; to drag family matters into politics is not my intention.

"But (my statement) has been twisted," he said when winding up the 2012 Budget debate for the Education Ministry today, in reply to the issue raised by Lim Kit Siang (DAP-Ipoh Timur).

Muhyiddin had on Saturday urged Lim to lodge a police report and to let police investigate and clear the air.

Muhyiddin, who is Education Minister, said he had not received any report on the alleged incident and said that he had never enquired the school to provide any detail.

Lim had blamed pro-Umno bloggers for claiming his (Lim's) son had molested a 16-year-old schoolmate.

"I didn't say that he (Lim's son) is guilty. I have no problem, but the society has its own perception," he said.
