

Muhyiddin Performs Friday Prayers In Setapak Surau

KUALA LUMPUR, March 2 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today performed Friday prayers at the At-Taqwa surau in Setapak in conjunction with his walkabout in Wangsa Maju and Setiawangsa.

He was accompanied by Federal Territories and Urban Well-being Minister Datuk Raja Nong Chik Raja Zainal Abidin, Batu Umno Division chief Datuk Yahaya Mat Ghani and Segambut Umno Division chief Datuk Kamaruddin Ambok.

Muhyiddin arrived at about 1 pm and joined almost 1,000 people at the house of worship for the prayers, after which he exchanged greetings with the congregation.

The prayers were led by Federal Territory Islamic Department (Jawi) director Datuk Che Mat Che Ali, who also delivered a sermon on "Love the Country".

Meanwhile, surau chairman Datuk Suffian Abd Rahim, when approached by reporters, said Surau At-Taqwa had received an allocation of about RM4.5 million from Jawi for upgrading.
