

Think Before Speaking, Muhyiddin Tells Mat Sabu

PAGOH, Aug 31 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said today PAS deputy president Mohamad Sabu should think before speaking.

"If he had inadvertently said something which he should not have, then he should ask for God's forgiveness and not repeat the mistake," he said when asked for his comment about the PAS leader's comments about the country's heroes.

Mohamad Sabu had, at a ceramah (talk) in Tasek Gelugor, Penang, on Aug 21, allegedly claimed that the communist terrorists who attacked and killed the 25 policemen and their families in Bukit Kepong in 1950 were heroes.

He had also allegedly said that Tunku Abdul Rahman and Datuk Onn Jaafar were not qualified to be regarded as independence fighters because they were officers of the British at that time.

Muhyiddin, who is Umno deputy president, expressed disappointment over Mohamad Sabu's alleged statement and described it as politics than anything else.
