

Muhyiddin Asks People To Elect Party With Good Track Record

KUALA PILAH, March 9 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin asked the people to ponder why they must elect the right party to form the government in the next general election.

He said the party must be able to uphold trust and responsibility to bring progress and development to the people and country.

It must also have a good track record of having implemented development programmes for the benefit of the people, he said when addressing religious teachers, mosque committee members and community leaders from Kuala Pilah in Johor here as part of his one-day visit to Negeri Sembilan.

He said the Barisan Nasional (BN) government had brought much development and progress for the people over the last 54 years since independence.

Muhyiddin, who is also education minister, also announced a total allocation of RM2.92 million for various projects, including upgrading of Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Cina Yoke Hua, Johor; erecting a bus shelter for Sekolah Menengah Rendah Agama Johor; upgrading Sekolah Kebangsaan Dato' Inas, Johor; building a new mosque in Gentam, Kuala Pilah, and undertaking flood mitigation in Kampung Padang Jual, Johor.

Later, in SEREMBAN, Muhyiddin asked BN leaders in the state to resolve all problems quickly to enable the coalition to win a two-third majority in parliament in the next general election.

He said all party members must remain united and not resort to squabbles because the BN lost in several areas in the last general election not because the opposition was strong but because there was sabotage within the BN.

Earlier, Muhyiddin held a meeting with committee members of the state Umno liaison committee at Wisma Umno Negeri.

He said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, who is BN chairman, had said that the next general election would be the "mother of all elections".
