"The 1Malaysia is a concept to unite all Malaysians and a symbol of the Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's people-oriented government," he reporters when visiting the 20-door Rh. Kaing Usit in Merurun near here.

On another matter, Salang said the government was always open to any communications technology that could help to correct the digital divide between urban and rural areas in the country.
