

**Opposition Duping The People On State Government Going Bust - Adnan Yaakob

TEMERLOH, March 14 (Bernama) -- The people in the state have been told not to be easily deceived by allegations and charges of the opposition that the state government is bankrupt and is thus not able to help the people and implement development projects in the state.

Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob said allegations that the state government had to borrow and undertake heavy debt as a result of lavish expenditure were not true.

"We have income from various resources including tax paid by investors, businessmen, land tax and so on.

"From the various revenue, the government was able to spend and help the people through development projects and this proved the accusations hurled by the opposition that the state government is bankrupt is utter rubbish," he said when handing over the 1Malaysia People's Aid (BR1M) to 4,000 residents of the Semantan state constituency in Temerloh, here Tuesday.

The state government will be giving subsidy to reduce the water bill of the people in Pahang and as an example, if the bill is RM1, 70 sen is undertaken by the government and only the balance of 30 sen would be paid by the consumer," he said.
