

Parliament: 7,000 Agree To Buy Houses Under PPR-MTEN Scheme

KUALA LUMPUR, March 14 (Bernama) -- About 7,000 tenants of public housings around the capital city have accepted an offer to buy homes under the Public Housing Programme-National Economic Action Council and Kuala Lumpur City Hall Public Housing scheme, to date.

They are the first group of buyers under the first phase of scheme, Federal Territories and Urban Wellbeing Minister Datuk Raja Nong Chik Raja Zainal Abidin told the Dewan Rakyat during question time.

The special financing scheme, announced by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak on June 28, started operating on March 1.

Answering a supplementary question from Nurul Izzah Anwar (PKR-Lembah Pantai), Raja Nong Chik said there should not be any doubts about the scheme because an agreement had been signed between the ministry and the Employees' Provident Fund on the matter.
