

Almost 60,000 Eligible Voters Yet To Register In Johor

JOHOR BAHRU, March 2 (Bernama) -- Almost 600,000 eligible individuals have yet to register as voters in Johor, state Election Commission director Rokiah Hanum Ibrahim said today.

Their number is large and it would be a waste if they do not register and exercise their right at the next general election, she said.

"A common misconception is that people can register today and vote tomorrow. Five months is needed before their names are inserted in the list of voters," she told Bernama.

She advised these individuals to immediately register with the appointed agents and not wait until the last minute.

The Johor EC has appointed more than 800 voter registration officers statewide from political parties, government departments and non-governmental organisations (NGO) to facilitate the registration of new voters, she said.

Johor has 56 state seats and 26 parliamentary seats.
