

BN Retreat Targets 12,000 Youngsters In Kedah

SUNGAI PETANI, March 2 (Bernama) -- Selected Barisan Nasional (BN) state assemblymen throughout the country participating in a retreat in Kedah over three days from today are expected to approach 12,000 young people during the programme, BN State Assembly Backbenchers Club chairman Datuk Nadzri Ismail said.

He said each of the 120 assemblymen would be required to meet 100 youngsters in assigned polling districts in Kedah, covering 14 of the 15 parliamentary constituencies and 34 of the 36 state constituencies.

"Each of them will be required to visit 30 houses in each assigned polling district, resulting in visits to a total of 3,600 houses under the programme," he told reporters assigning the assemblymen at the hall of the Mara Skills Institute, here.

Nadzri said the participation of the assemblymen in the programme would show the people that BN assemblymen understand the people's needs and can champion their plight.

Nadzri said the assemblymen's retreat programme would be implemented continuously as a new approach to enable the elected representatives to understand the pulse of the people," he said.
