

**Customs Department Aims To Collect RM32 Billion In Indirect Taxes This Year**

KUALA LUMPUR, March 6 (Bernama) -- The Royal Malaysian Customs Department aims to collect RM32 billion in indirect taxes this year, Director-General Datuk Mohamed Khalid Yusuf said Tuesday.

Last year, RM30.4 billion was collected, he said.

He said the adoption of the new TS4 passive TeraHertz detection system in February, which could detect contraband concealed under passengers' clothing, would come in handy to realise this year's target.

"The TS4 is the latest detection equipment we are using at KLIA currently. If there is a new and more efficient equipment in the market, we will buy it also (to enhance our operations)," he told reporters at the Third World Customs Organisation Technology and Innovation Forum 2012.

Khalid said his department has collected RM5 billion in indirect taxes in January and February.
