

Noh Objects Selangor Government Proposal To Take Over Management Of Botanical Garden

SHAH ALAM, March 11 (Bernama) -- The Minister of Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Datuk Seri Noh Omar has objected the Selangor state government's proposal to take over the Shah Alam National Botanical Garden (TBNSA), here.

He said this was because the federal government through the ministry had allocated about RM161 million for implementation of the TBNSA master plan to become a major national agro tourism centre.

"I have been informed that the Selangor state government is in the process of taking over of the Botanical Garden management here on the pretext that the allocation channeled by the federal government to develop the park was insufficient," he told a news conference after a visit to TBNSA, here Sunday.
