

Azizan Plans To Go On Leave, Doesn't Intend To Appoint Acting MB

ALOR SETAR, March 14 (Bernama) -- Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Azizan Abdul Razak today expressed his intention to go on leave but does not plan to appoint an acting Menteri Besar during his absence.

Azizan said if he had the opportunity, he would go on leave but he had yet to decide whether to take a long or short vacation.

"Going on leave is no big deal, just take the suitcase and buy an air ticket, then you fly. The vacation can be long or short. Not necessary to appoint someone to take over just to visit one's grandchild.

"No acting (Menteri Besar), everything is in order, the storm has disappeared," he told reporters after chairing an Exco meeting, here.

In another development, Azizan said the state government regretted the incident concerning Foong Chun Yuan, 5, who died after hitting the glass door at the Kuala Kedah Jetty on Friday.
