

**Kedah Contractors Association Worries State Government Crisis Affecting
Development

PENDANG, March 14 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Malay Contractors Association has expressed its concern over the crisis plaguing the state government recently which could affect the development of the state.

Its chairman, Ahmad Fatahi Omar said should the crisis prolong, the people would not be able to enjoy continuous development and contractors would not get any project from the government.

Ahmad Fatahi said he regretted that the state government was now shaky and unstable which badly hit Malay contractors depending on government projects in the state.

He also admitted since the state was administered by the opposition coalition in 2008, contractors registered in Kedah had found jobs hard to come by.

He said the state government needed a good development plan to enable the state to develop smoothly as was done by the federal government.
