

PSC To Reconsider Stand On Reducing Postal Voting - Ongkili

KUALA LUMPUR, March 14 (Bernama) -- Parliamentary Select Committee (PSC) for Electoral Reforms chairman Datuk Seri Dr Maximus Ongkili said the committee was reconsidering its stand on reducing postal voting.

This follows the Election Commission (EC) decision to allow Malaysians abroad to cast their votes via postal voting.

Dr Ongkili said this was because the move by the EC was not in line with the committee's stand to reduce the number in postal voting. He said the PSC would discuss the issue next week, including the terms and conditions, to allow Malaysians abroad to vote via postal votes.

"We may make it very simple, maybe, just one or two conditions," he told reporters after chairing a meeting in Parliament Wednesday.

The committee would sit for three more meetings before tabling its final report to the Dewan Rakyat, he said.
