

**Suspension For Members Attempting To Sabotage Party - MCA**

KUALA LUMPUR, March 14 (Bernama) -- MCA will suspend any member found to be sabotaging the party as it gears up for the coming general election, which could be called soon.

Party secretary-general Datuk Seri Kong Cho Ha explained that the move aimed to handle the internal bickering and sabotage which still posed threats to the party.

"To stop internal politics, especially with the general election drawing nearer, any member found to be sabotaging the party will be referred to the Disciplinary Board and can be suspended for six months," he told Bernama here today.

However, he noted that the party had yet to receive any formal complaints so far but would monitor the situation as such incidents normally occurred after the announcement of the candidates list.

"We haven't received any complaints so far. Of course, election is not called yet. However, we will monitor the situation to ensure they cooperate, especially at the division and branch levels.
