

**Give Opportunities In Garbage Disposal To Non-Bumi Contractors - Selangor MCA Bureau

PETALING JAYA, Feb 17 (Bernama) -- The Selangor MCA Public Complaints Bureau has urged the state government to give garbage disposal contracts to non-Bumiputera companies too in areas under the administration of the Subang Jaya Municipal Council (MPSJ).

Bureau head Datuk Theng Book said he was made to understand that on Feb 1, the MPSJ had awarded cleaning contracts to 154 companies which were all Bumiputera-owned.

"I regret the attitude of the State Executive Council members, especially the DAP representatives who do not 'walk the talk'. The DAP always emphasises that it is fair to everyone regardless of race and religion, but in awarding waste disposal tenders, it only gives priority to one particular race," he said.

He disclosed this at a media conference of the bureau on the issue of waste disposal and dengue cases in Selangor, here today.

A Mandarin news portal ([mykampung.sinchew.com.my](http://mykampung.sinchew.com.my)) dated Feb 9, reported that 154 Bumiputera garbage collection contractors were awarded garbage collection and sanitary contracts in the Subang Jaya area.

Theng claimed that when the state government was administered by the Barisan Nasional before the 12th general election, Selangor had never sidelined the non-Bumiputeras in the awarding of contracts.

"Therefore, I call on Teresa Kok (Selangor State Executive Councillor) to answer our question, what happened to their promise of equality for all races," he said.
