

**PAS Inconsistent, Strays From Islamic Principles - Shafie

ALOR SETAR, March 18 (Bernama) -- PAS is inconsistent in its Islamic struggle and has strayed from its principles by asking Muslims to cooperate and establish ties with Jews.

Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Mohd Shafie Apdal said PAS' stand on the issue as declared by its president Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang recently proves that it is an unprincipled party.

"PAS has been highly critical of Umno for alleged links with Israel but Hadi's statement proves that the party is not inline with Islamic struggle.

"PAS spiritual leader Datuk Nik Aziz Nik Mat said we can't trade or cooperate with Jews but Hadi said the opposite," Shafie told reporters at 'Mesra Rakyat Bersama Menteri' programme in Ayer Hitam, Jerlun today.

Also present were Kedah Umno liaison chairman Datuk Ahmad Bashah Md Hanipah and his deputy and Jerlun MP, Datuk Mukhriz Tun Dr Mahathir.

Speaking at a Muslimat PAS function in Shah Alam, Hadi said cooperation with Jews who did not adhere to Zionist ideology was allowed.

Shafie said that PAS' struggle in humanitarian issues like the Palestinians and the implementation of hudud law were also unclear.
