

**Election System Subject In School Needs Comprehensive Study - Puad

SEREMBAN, March 23 (Bernama) -- Deputy Education Minister Dr Mohd Puad Zarkashi said Friday the suggestion that the country's election system be made a chapter in any subject in school needs to be studied first by the ministry's Curriculum Development Division.

"This is because it involves teachers, scheduling and we need to see at what stages it should be taught, whether at secondary or primary.

"Maybe it can be incorporated in existing subjects such as history, local studies and so on," he told reporters after opening the Parent-Teacher's Association meeting of Sekolah Wawasan Seremban 2 here today.

Yesterday, Election Commission deputy chairman Datuk Wira Wan Ahmad Wan Omar said the introduction to the subject at an early stage would enable the young to know their responsibilities upon attaining the age which allowed them to register as electors and vote.
