

**Protect Sanctity Of Mosque Institution - Sultan Mizan

BESUT, Feb 24 (Bernama) - The Sultan of Terengganu, Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin says that all mosque or surau projects must have permission of Terengganu Islamic and Malay Customs Council (Maidam).

He said the same applies for the appointment of iman, bilal and mosque committees while mosque or surau sites should be declared to standardise and avoid duplication in mosque management.

"Maidam is authorised to coordinate and manage mosques under Terengganu Islamic Affairs Administration Enactment 2001," he said when opening Masjid Ulul Albab Seberang Jerteh, here.

The RM12mil wooden mosque completed in July last year can accommodate about 1,500 Muslims at any one time.

Sultan Mizan hopes that the mosque management be more responsible to avoid breach of trust as it is detrimental to the sanctity of the mosque institution.
