

Government Freezes Development On River Reserves

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 25 (Bernama) -- The government has decided to freeze development on river reserves in the Klang Valley for three years from Feb 8 this year under the "River of Life" project to preserve the areas along the Gombak and Klang rivers.

Federal Territories and Urban Well-being Ministry secretary-general Datuk Ahmad Phesal Talib said the 144 hectares would be frozen from all kinds of public-private sector partnership, privatisation, sale or substitution.

He said in a statement that the "River of Life" project was one of the nine Entry Point Projects (EPP) under the Greater Kuala Lumpur/Klang Valley initiative.
